GUIDED WALKING TOURS

Rockville at 200 Years – *overview of Rockville history* – from Courthouse Square and around the Town Center, Rockville's story from the 1750s to the present

Rockville During the Civil War – *Civil War era Rockville* – visit places JEB Stuart and Jubal Early saw and meet Rockville residents of this traumatic period

B&O Station, Wire Hardware, Saint Mary's – *19th century landmarks* – visit Rockville's oldest chapel, F. Scott Fitzgerald's grave, and structures from the railroad era

History Hunt -- *family scavenger hunt* – check out landmarks around the Town Center

Underground Railroad in Rockville – *"stealing" freedom in Rockville* – visit landmarks around Town Center and hear the stories of Josiah Henson (the model for Uncle Tom) and others on Rockville's Underground Railroad

Public Architecture in Town Center – *monuments and buildings of the Recent Past and other eras* – the seat of Montgomery County government has always been a location to commemorate events, people, and history

F. Scott Fitzgerald in Rockville – *for literary buffs* -- places FSF visited in Rockville as well as his gravesite

Downtown Rockville – *center of government and commerce* – see how we have changed over the years

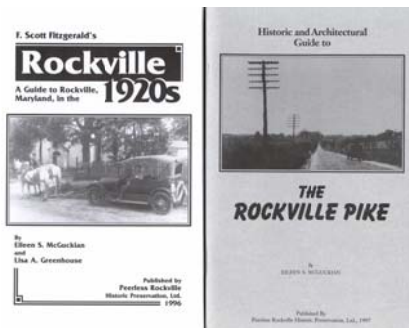
Rockville Cemetery -- *beautiful historic landscape* – meet the people who made Rockville

Red Brick Courthouse – *Montgomery County landmark* – architecture and history of 1891 building

1803 Boundary – *early Rockville history* – settlement in the 18th and early 19th centuries
