Since 1979, Peerless Rockville has recognized outstanding achievement in the design, maintenance, and preservation of Rockville's built environment and exemplary contributions to Rockville's quality of life.

The Awards Ceremony will be presented in May or June; details to be announced.

Peerless Rockville is a non-profit organization, founded in 1974, whose mission is to safeguard and promote Rockville's past by preserving buildings, spaces, objects, and information important to our city's heritage. Peerless Rockville advances its goals through research, advocacy, education, and community involvement.

Award Categories:

A. The Peerless Rockville Awards Program honors individuals, organizations, institutions, and businesses whose projects, activities, or programs contribute to the City of Rockville's architectural character and/or cultural heritage. Nominations may include, but are not limited to, the following categories; more than one category may apply:

B. The Wagman Award for Historic Preservation Communication honors outstanding achievement by writers, visual and performing artists, educators, members of the media, composers, and filmmakers whose work has informed, enhanced, or augmented public awareness of Rockville's architectural and cultural heritage, growth, and development. Instituted in 2001, the award is named for Arthur M. Wagman, a Peerless Rockville founder and its attorney for the first thirty years.

Award Requirements:

- Projects are applicable to any area of the greater Rockville community and are not limited to historic districts;
- Projects must represent noteworthy or exemplary standards;
- Projects must be completed at the time of nomination; if the project has distinct phases, the phase for which the project is nominated must be completed;
- Projects must have been completed within 2 years prior to nomination; and
- Owner/nominee will be contacted to arrange a site visit during March.
